



Characteristics of the Nanny Service Operation at Levante Beach, in the Enclosed Park in Front of the Family Beach Area

The following text outlines the functioning of the aspects involved in the development of the Nanny Service project at Levante Beach, in the enclosed park in front of the Family Beach Area. This programme is part of the "Time x Care" transfer initiative by the Department of Equality and Feminisms of the Generalitat de Catalunya.

It is a temporary care service in a fun and quality space for children. The goal is to provide basic care, social recreation, and educational leisure activities for children, while facilitating work-life balance, family, and personal time for families and providing personal respite time.

Legal Framework

The legal framework regulating this project is Resolution IFE/3681/2023, dated 31 October 2023, by the Department of Equality and Feminisms, which approves the transfer intended to fund the provision of temporary care service for children aged 0 to 16 years in municipalities with more than 20,000 inhabitants and to county councils for the fiscal year 2023, which can be executed during 2023 and 2024.

Article 15, on temporary play centres, of Decree 94/2009, dated 9 June, on Play Centres.

Access Requirements

To access the Nanny Service at Levante Beach, in the enclosed park in front of the Family Beach Area, children who are enrolled from P3 to 4th grade of primary school can access the service.

Children who are still in nappies cannot access the service as we do not have the necessary facilities to properly accommodate these children at this developmental stage.

Users may be admitted or excluded on an exceptional basis, provided there is a report specifying the relevant arguments, always aiming for the correct development of the service.

In any case, the admission of a user will always be subject to the relevant registration, within the deadlines stated in the service characteristics document,

providing the required documentation and following all the conditions stipulated therein.

- The service is open from Tuesday to Sunday, from 16:30 to 20:30, and the maximum daily time a child can use the service during weekdays is 2 hours and 30 minutes per day.
- There will be 24 places available per time slot.
- The maximum monthly time a child can use the service is 12.5 hours.

Registrations

To use the service, it is necessary to fill in the registration form, which requires the signature of a legal guardian on a registration document and an agreement to accept the internal operating regulations of the centre, or a form with the necessary and relevant information about the child (including health information) and other relevant data.

Up to 24 children can be registered daily for the nanny service from Tuesday to Sunday. However, the council may vary the number of places occasionally if deemed appropriate.

The child must be accompanied to and picked up from the service by

their legal guardian, parent, or a delegated person. This person must be clearly identified.

It is recommended that parents bring the necessary materials for their child's care (spare clothes, etc.). If the child needs to eat while using the service, they should bring a backpack with the food they need to consume.

Priority Criteria

The following groups will have priority access to the service:

- Single-parent families and/or those with other verified care responsibilities.
- Long-term unemployed mothers.
- Self-employed mothers.
- Mothers over 45 years old.
- Migrant mothers.
- Mothers experiencing domestic violence.
- Families with income above a certain threshold.
- Families with children with disabilities or special needs.
- Referrals from social services.
- Large families.
- Families with two or more children registered for the service.

These groups will have priority if the available places are filled.

Image Rights

The authorisation or refusal of image rights for the child will be the responsibility of the family. The council will provide the option to authorise or not the use of images in accordance with the law.
